We would like to take a moment to praise all of our children for their excellent understanding and mature attitude towards our school's lockdown procedures. Their calmness, curiosity, and thoughtful questions have shown just how seriously they take their own safety and the wellbeing of others.

As part of our commitment to keeping everyone safe, we will be carrying out a lockdown drill this half term. Before this, we'll remind children of the alarm sound and what to expect, so they feel confident and prepared. We understand that some children may feel a little unsure, and we want to reassure you that any child who has expressed concerns to their class teacher has been—and will continue to be—supported sensitively and appropriately.
