**Attendance – The League and attendance update (Please note, we work a week behind due to the Friday marks not being populated before the Friday Letter is issued).**

**0 points if attendance is below 96%**

**1 point awarded for weekly attendance figures between 96% - 97.5%**

**2 points awarded for weekly attendance figures between 97.6% - 98.9%**

**3 points awarded for weekly attendance figures between 99% - 100%**

3 points awarded for Year 4 this week – well done, you are top of the League. A bit more positive looking at some of those figures, with 62.5% of classes making progress.

With the introduction of our new system (Arbor), we will begin sending you a weekly message about your child's attendance.

These messages will include the following information:

- **100% and above 96% attendance** – We believe it is important to celebrate success and excellent attendance.
- **Below 96%** – A reminder of the attendance level expected for all pupils.
- **Persistent Absentee (PA)** – Attendance **below 90%**.

Please also be aware that if your child falls into the **Persistent Absentee** category:

- You **will receive a visit** from a member of the school team.
- If we are unable to make contact, a letter may be posted to inform you of the visit.
- If attendance does not improve, **future absences may not be authorised**, and a meeting in school will be arranged.

Thank you for your cooperation as we continue to work together to support every child's attendance and wellbeing.
