



Year 6 Transition Days at Heworth Grange School 2026

We are really looking forward to welcoming Year 6 students for a visit to Heworth Grange **on Tuesday 30th June and Wednesday 1st July 2026**. This will be an exciting opportunity for your child to experience a taste of life at Heworth. We know that lots of Year 6 students have already visited us for some of the many Primary Sports and Arts events that have taken place at Heworth this year, and these two days will be a chance for all our 'new Year 7's' to come together.

Each of the two transition days will run from **9am – 2.30pm** and will be packed full of things to do, to see and to take part in, so please ensure your child arrives between **9-9:10am** for a prompt start to the day. Students should arrive at the main entrance gate and will be greeted by staff and our student ambassadors who will show them where to go and be on hand to look after them throughout the day. The first day at a new school might make some students a little bit nervous, but if parents/carers can say their goodbyes quickly at the gate, we will take good care of them.

Students should attend both days wearing their current primary school uniform and bring with them a pen and pencil for their taster lessons. Students will also be provided with a lunchtime meal, but if your child would rather bring a packed lunch they can do so, and payment for meals will be organised with their primary school. At the end of each day students will leave via the main gate as normal just before the rest of the school cohort.

Alongside the transition days there will be a meeting for all parents/carers on **Tuesday 16th of June**.
