How Does it Work?

Our specially trained teaching assistant, Mrs Baker, delivers up to 30 half-hour sessions to a group of up to four children in Year 1 or Year 2, for 10 -15 weeks. The sessions are over and above the children's daily mathematics lessons.

The lessons focus on number and calculation, developing children's mathematical understanding, communication and reasoning skills. Stimulating, enjoyable games and activities engage the children and build their confidence.

We have had fantastic results over the years whereby low attaining children, who have completed the programme, have been able to work alongside their peers much more confidently in their daily mathematics lessons.

How Does it Work?

Our specially trained teaching assistant, Ms Johnson, delivers up to 30 half-hour sessions to a group of up to three children in Year 3 or Year 4. The sessions are over and above the children's daily mathematics lessons.

This is a light touch calculation-based intervention for learners in Key Stage 2 who have difficulties with arithmetic proficiency and need support to improve their understanding of the number system and develop fluency with number facts. It helps them to make faster progress and to catch up with their peers through a mastery approach.
