



All our children have returned to full-time education in September 2020 following the COVID closure. We hope that most of our children will have an uninterrupted experience. However, there is the possibility that individual children, a class bubble, or the whole school, will need to self-isolate or there will be a local lockdown, for a period of time. Therefore, the school has put in place a plan for remote learning so that all children can continue with their education. This meets the expectations set out in the DfE guidance 'Remote Education Support'.

All our children have a Purple Mash account. This allows them to have access to all online resources and maintain contact with class teachers and other staff through this platform. If a child does not have access to a computer/laptop and/or the internet, the school will do all it can to support children and will provide paper packs of learning. It is important parents have made the school aware of any barriers to accessing remote learning (Questionnaire sent 25<sup>th</sup> September).

### **Initial Two-Day Plan (beginning of isolation)**

An initial plan for the first two days of remote learning will be issued on the day children need to self-isolate (sent home – paper pack). This two-day plan/pack will allow staff time to plan remote learning for children in line with the classes current curriculum. It will provide learning across the curriculum and children will be expected to spend a similar amount of time completing this as they would spend learning in school. ### **Remote Class Learning – 3<sup>rd</sup> day of isolation**

After the first two days, the class teacher will have planned learning activities that will enable the child/children to continue the learning journeys they had started in the classroom. This remote learning will be on Purple Mash. Children in Rec-Y6 will log on and complete the activities published in the 2do section, this may include watching video clips and listening to audio tutorials. Work will be set **DAILY** and be required to be handed in on the day of completion. **PLEASE BE MINDFUL, THIS IS EXPECTED LEARNING AND WILL BE MONITORED CLOSELY.** TT Rockstars, numbots, Readingplus and Lexia is still expected for homework activities and/or part of the timetabled activities. If it is the class teacher who is unwell, there may be some differences with this provision.

### **EYFS**

Class learning packs will be on the school website and further activities and lessons will be on Purple Mash.

### **SEND**

If a child has SEND and has specific learning interventions and support, we will aim to continue this provision in an adapted form online if appropriate.
